### Executive Committee Business – Erin Huneke

- **BOCC Approval:** The Board of County Commissioners will consider a vote next week to recommend the new Douglas County LEPC membership to the state.
- October Full Board: The next board meeting will take place at the Eudora Community Center with a presentation on World Cup, hopefully by a representative from KC2026. The January Full Board meeting will most likely take place in Baldwin City with a presentation on large pre-planned events by Chief Mike Pattrick.

- New Staff: Robert introduced the new EM intern, Ellie Hall.
- Planning
  - o EOP:
    - The third-quarter review (ESF#3, 11, 12, 14) is scheduled for August 20, 2025.
    - Active Threat and Mass Fatality Plans were finalized and rolled out in July 2025, with a potential exercise in the first half of 2026.
    - New plans supporting EOP (e.g., Drought, Flood, and Fire) are in the final stages of development, with drafts expected for work group review by the end of Q3 2025.
  - IPP: No update. Please continue to encourage partners to complete the survey.
  - COOP: No update. EM continues to be available to support partners.
  - Mitigation: EM has collected all promulgation documentation from all jurisdictions who have adopted the regional mitigation plan.

• EMPG: 2025 funding appears to be intact. EM will apply for and receive that funding in early 2026. A notice of opportunity has gone out for EMPG for 2026 which the state will apply for.

 Sections of Douglas County Unified Command continue to meet. We should have much more information by mid-December when the first round of teams are determined.

### Construction—

- EM met with Emergency Communications and contractors to discuss antenna needs and placement at the new Public Safety Building.

- All volunteers will have the opportunity to take CPR/AED and Stop the Bleed training in the coming weeks.

- Two volunteers will attend the National CERT Conference this week thanks to donated funds.

- EM presented at the second round of the Lawrence Police Department's Police Camp and Teen Academy in July.
