
Order Appointing Pro Tem Judge


Order Appointing Pro Tem Judge

And


Care and Treatment Cases


Order Pertaining to Appointment of Attorneys to Represent Juveniles


Revised Order Pertaining to Appointment of Attorneys to Represent Juveniles



CRIMINAL EXPUNGEMENT DOCKET

Pursuant to Administrative Order 20-37, there will be a standing expungement docket in Division 5 on the third Tuesday of each month at 1 :30 p.m. In the event a petition for expungement is filed in any case, the division assignment of the case will not change, but the hearing on the petition shall be scheduled according to this order. Division 5 may adjust the docket as it deems necessary for management of the Court's overall caseload.


Expungement petitions will be scheduled for hearing on the expungement docket in the second month after the filing of the petition, excluding the month that the petition is filed in. For example, a petition filed in January will be scheduled for hearing on the March expungement docket.

Regardless of the division assignment of the case for which expungement is sought, the Court Clerk shall:

1. Schedule the matter on the appropriate docket in accordance with the above directive;
2. Send notice of hearing to the district attorney and the person filing the petition (except if represented by counsel, notice shall instead be provided to counsel). The Court Clerk shall not be responsible for sending notice to any other interested person or agency. Any such additional notice required pursuant to K.S.A. 21-6614 shall be the responsibility of the party as set forth in the statute.
3. The Court Clerk shall redirect any petition or proposed order for expungement, or any related filing, to the Division 5 e-flex queue for review and determination.

Any party may request that a hearing on a petition for expungement be heard by another division judge when there exist circumstances that the party believes justify such a request. In that event, the request should be directed to the attention of the Chief Judge for determination.

NOW ON this 27th date of June 2025, the court has been duly advised of facts demonstrating that Kansas attorney Randall K. Reitz, Kansas Bar Number 9819, of Lawrence, Kansas, has been transferred to disabled status by the Kansas Supreme Court under Rule 234 (2025 Kan. S. Ct. R. at 294) and that there is a need for the appointment of an attorney to protect the interests of his clients. This order is filed under seal to protect the financial account information contained within.

Wherefore, the court appoints Hatem Chahine Kansas Bar Number 20047 pursuant to Rule 235 (2025 Kan. S. Ct. R. at 300) to review and inventory the attorney's client files and the attorney's trust account and take such action, including the distribution of funds, as may be necessary to protect the interests of the attorney or his clients.

Hatem Chahine is authorized to access and control Randall K. Reitz's attorney trust account held at Intrust Bank, P.O. Box 1, Wichita, Kansas 667201 account number [REDACTED]. Hatem Chahine may distribute funds from the trust account to the owners of the funds. If the owner of funds cannot be located after reasonable attempts, Hatem Chahine will transfer the funds under the Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act, K.S.A. 58-3950, *et seq.* If after reasonable measures to identify the owner of funds in the trust account there remain funds in the trust account for whom the owner is unidentifiable, Hatem Chahine will distribute those funds to the Client Protection Fund under Rules 235(a)(2)(C) (protect client interests) and 241(c)(4) (client protection fund).


Hatem Chahine may seek additional orders from the district court if necessary.

Order Directing Collections


Pursuant to Section (A)(1) of the Collection of Restitution and Debts Owed Work Plan for the Seventh Judicial District, the Court may refer delinquent cases, regardless of the age of the case, to the Contractor, Butler & Associates, P.A., for collection activities, with the exception of sealed cases. The Chief Judge will determine the case types that may be referred to the Contractor, when a case is considered delinquent, and retains the authority to recall a case from collections at any time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following parameters shall be applied by the Clerk of the District Court and their deputies when referring a case to Butler & Associates, P.A., for collection activities.

- (1) Traffic cases with the case type TR, except cases with a charge of Driving Under the Influence, shall be referred to Butler & Associates, P.A. for collection activities if the assessed costs are not paid in full by 60 calendar days following the disposition date of the case (including cases dismissed at defendant's cost).
- (2) Traffic (TR) cases and criminal cases with the case type CR that have entered into a Diversion Agreement with the District Attorney's Office or have been granted probation from a jail or prison sentence shall NOT be referred to Butler & Associates, P.A. for collection activities until the completion of such diversion or probation.
- (3) Criminal (CR) cases, and traffic (TR) cases with a charge of Driving Under the Influence shall NOT be referred to Butler & Associates, P.A. for collection activities if the defendant was sentenced to time in prison or jail, unless specifically ordered by the Court.
- (4) Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, the Clerk of the District Court and their deputies shall NOT refer any other case type to Butler & Associates, P.A. for collection activity.

This Administrative Order will terminate on December 31, 2025, unless otherwise ordered by the Court. This Administrative Order is effective starting the date signed below.






