LAW CHANGES TO EXEMPT CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY FROM TAXATION

In 2025, Kansas lawmakers made significant changes in what personal property can and cannot be taxed in 2026 and going forward:

Personal Property Tax Exempt in 2026	Personal Property Still Being Taxed in 2026
 Watercraft / marine equipment	 Mobile homes
 Off-road vehicles such as all-terrain,  recreational off-highway, golf cart,  off-road motorcycle and snowmobile  vehicles	 Tiny homes
 Motorized bicycle, electric assisted  bicycle or scooter/moped	 Aircraft
 Any trailer that has a gross weight of  15,000 lbs. or less, and is exclusively for personal use and not for the production of income	 Antique titled vehicles
	 Salvage title vehicles
	 Vehicles with heavy tags such as 16/20 or higher
	 Oil & Gas leases
	 RVs / RV Trailers 

In other words, if you own personal property that is indicated above as **Personal Property Tax Exempt in 2026** then no action is needed on your behalf. This property will still be taxed for time it was owned prior to January 1, 2026.

If you own any personal property that is indicated above as **Personal Property Still Being Taxed in 2026**, then you will receive a value notice in May 2026 and will receive a tax bill in November 2026. For these items you are still required to notify our office of any changes to your personal property. Examples of changes that should be reported include: the purchase of new personal property, the sale of personal property, changes in the use, and/or changes in where the property is stored.
